

Summer Schedule for the Children

The summer church schedule begins today with the worship service beginning at 9:30 AM.

Volunteers are needed in 3 areas:

Children's Message – about 5 minutes during the worship service

Kid's Church – ages 3 years through 1st grade

Nursery – standby in case babies come during worship service

Beginning today and continuing through September 2, children ages 3 years through 2nd grade will attend the first part of the church worship service (service begins at 9:30 A.M.). Following the Children's Message, they will be dismissed to their classroom for a lesson and activities. Materials and lessons will be provided. Little if any preparation is needed. Please consider signing up for 1 or 2 weeks – sign-up poster is located in the Chapel area on the wood wall. There are 3 categories: nursery, children's message, and Kids' Church. *We strongly encourage children in 3rd grade and up to remain in church.* Thank you and God bless you for volunteering – you will have fun!

For Kids' Church Volunteers: This summer, each lesson will focus on people of the Bible. Lesson ideas and materials are in individual folders in the blue bin. Additional materials are either in the 2nd bin or in the classroom cabinet.

Please feel free to adapt the lessons and add to them as you wish. For the lessons, I have included a number of activities – you may need to pick and choose for the sake of time. If you need extra activities, there is always playdough and games in the cabinet. Have fun with the kids!
